Who: Parish Bereavement Ministry Directors and Ministers and those who accompany the bereaved. Space permitting, Diocesan Restorative Justice Directors, Priests, Women Religious, Deacons, Chaplains and other interested parties may be able to attend.

What: Participants will learn how to more effectively minister to survivors of violent crime, particularly those who've experienced the death of a loved one to homicide.

When: Begins at 1pm Tuesday, May 7– Ends at 1pm, Thursday, May 9, 2019.

Where: Mater Dolorosa Passionist Retreat Center, 700 N. Sunnyside Avenue, Sierra Madre. Fly into Burbank Airport. Then allow 20-40 mins. to drive to Mater Dolorosa.

What is included: Training, accommodations and all meals are free.

What is not included: Flights and ground transportation are your own responsibility.

Objectives: Participants will gain insight into and understanding of the impact of homicide on survivors, and explore concrete ways to minister to them. In addition, they will learn about the criminal justice system's response to survivors and things to consider when developing opportunities for ongoing support.
